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## **About Resettlement**

- Our employment team consists of career coaches and job developers who work together to place our refugee clients into jobs in our community
  - Job Developers work closer with employers, Career Coaches work closer with clients and developing their career paths
  - Self-sufficiency goal: aim for 180 days of self-sufficiency
- All clients referred to our employment team have work authorization in the form of an EAD, I-94, CO ID, and/or SSN's. Ask a JD if you are unfamiliar with any of the I9 documentation forms
- We appreciate transparency: we understand that hiring refugees can be a difficult task and we are very transparent when recognizing all the barriers. All we ask if for transparency back as far as who you are willing to hire and for what pay!





## **Our Clients**

- Refugees are individuals who are forced to flee their countries
  of origin because of a well-founded fear of persecution due to
  race, religion, nationality, or membership in a particular social or
  political group.
- Asylees are people already in the United States who receive protected status and are unable to return home for the same reasons that refugees are unable to return home.
- Victims of Trafficking are people who have been forced, deceived, or coerced to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act. Victims can be any age, race, gender, or nationality. Human trafficking, also known as trafficking in persons, is a form of modern-day slavery in which traffickers may lure individuals with false promises of employment and a better life. Immigration relief is provided to eligible victims.
- Special Immigrant Visa (SIV) Holders are those individuals who have been granted special immigrant status on account of their service to US military and/or contractors abroad. Individuals are granted SIV status for their support of the United States government and its affiliates.
- Humanitarian Parole allows an individual, who may be inadmissible or otherwise ineligible for admission into the United States, to be paroled into the United States for a temporary period for urgent humanitarian reasons or significant public benefit.
